

# 2025 Aboriginal VET Scholarships

## VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING

### About the scholarships

Newmont Boddington (NB) is offering two pre-apprenticeship scholarship opportunities in qualifications linked to priority trade areas in NB's annual apprenticeship program intake. The scholarships will be awarded to Aboriginal peoples preferably from the local Wilman Traditional Owner; Gnaala Karla Booja (GKB) Native Title Claimant Group and/or Noongar Aboriginal people who are enrolled or applying for entry into the identified South Regional TAFE (SR TAFE) priority pathways.

### Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must be:

- an Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident
- of Aboriginal descent with connection with NB's key Aboriginal stakeholder groups including: Wilman Traditional Owner; Gnaala Karla Booja Native Title Claimant Group; and/or Noongar Aboriginal people
- enrolled in listed scholarship area of priority 1 or priority 2

Applicants will have an interest and commitment to a course of study and interest in a trade career in the mining industry.

Successful recipients may have the opportunity to undertake a work placement at Newmont Boddington operation during the pre-apprenticeship training and will be encouraged to apply for an apprenticeship program upon course completion.

### Selection process

SR TAFE and the Jobs and Skill Centres (JSC) can assist applicants to complete the application form and forward applications to Newmont Boddington for selection for the annual scholarship.

### What is the scholarship?

The scholarship covers the full SR TAFE course fees and up to \$500 towards study costs.

### How to apply

Visit one of the South West JSCs to get support to complete the application. JSCs are located at Bunbury and Collie.
